SUBJECT: 2017-18 School-Based ACCESS Program Statewide Training Sessions

The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) are announcing the schedule for annual statewide training sessions to be offered to all participating School-Based Access Program (SBAP) teams.

These sessions are scheduled at eight different locations across the commonwealth. You may register to attend a session based on your location and availability. Registration is required (instructions below).

<u>Participation is strongly encouraged</u>. Local educational agencies are encouraged to assign at least one representative to attend a training in order to receive important SBAP information. No downlink sites will be available.

#### WHAT TRAINING IS BEING OFFERED?

#### **SBAP General Session**

Training will be led and information presented by DHS. The General Session will review policy highlights of the SBAP and the Provider Handbook, SBAP annual performance and claiming levels, and lessons learned from monitoring reviews. Attendees will learn what information they will be required to provide, how they will provide it, and what the timeline is for completing SBAP requirements.

#### **Breakout Sessions**

After the general session, the following breakout sessions will be offered (you will have the opportunity to attend all three sessions).

# **Breakout Session (A): Cost Settlement**

This session will be led by Sivic Solutions Group (SSG) and will focus on cost settlement. Attendees will learn more about:

- System Updates & New Features
- What is on the Direct Medical List?

#### **Breakout Session (B): Random Moment Time Study (RMTS)**

This session will be led by Public Consulting Group (PCG) and will focus on the relationship between staff and costs and how staff pool updates in RMTS impact LEA's Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC) and overall SBAP reimbursement. Attendees will learn more about:

This session will be led by the DHS's Bureau of Program Integrity and will focus on tools to successfully complete an SBAP audit. Attendees will learn more about:
